# TJC & CMS Environment of Care Update-How to Prepare for Changes in Joint Commission Survey Standards and Processes in 2018

## **Program Overview**

In Environment of Care, 2016 and 2017 were benchmark years for healthcare change in compliance. The 2012 Life Safety Code was adopted by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, (CMS). The Joint Commission restructured the survey process using "Project Refresh". Many survey elements of performance, (EP) were removed, along with the use of the Plan for Improvement Process in the electronic statement of conditions. New EP's were added reflecting the changes in codes. CMS wrote a new emergency preparedness directive for use in healthcare. This program will discuss these changes along with strategies to prepare for the new survey process.

## **Program Objectives**

- 1. Review what has changed in the Joint Commission Survey Process.
- 2. Describe changes in the new CMS emergency management program and how they affect healthcare.
- 3. Identify changes between the 2000 and 2012 edition Life Safety Code.
