

# USP 797 & TJC Medication Management Standards

## Program Overview

Chapter 797 sets forth standards regarding staff training, facility design, expiration dating of compounded medications, environmental monitoring, storage of compounded products, testing of finished compounds & overall staff responsibilities for sterile medication compounding. Gain insight into the latest proposed changes to USP General Chapter 797 & how TJC will survey for compliance and score findings.

USP General Chapter 797 will impact not only pharmacy operations, but the way injectable, intravenous, intraocular & intrathecal medications are managed across healthcare organizations.
