## Program Overview

This program addresses leadership responsibilities and techniques related to rounding for quality and patient safety on the nursing unit. Additionally, discussion will include the potential consequences when organizations lack the leadership oversight that rounding provides. This presentation will address how leaders can model their commitment to quality and patient safety and build credibility among the staff.
